Since 1997, Peter Blom has been the CEO of Triodos Bank, co-founder and chair of the Global Alliance for Banking of Values and was admitted to the Club of Rome in 2010 for his services.

Fabio Brescacin opened, with a group of friends, one of the first organic food stores in Italy. In 1987 he was among the founders of Gea, that later became EcorNaturasi S.p.A., now the leading distributor of organic and biodynamic products in Italy, dedicated to specialist retail.

Helmy Abouleish has been Managing Director of SEKEM for 30 years and CEO of SEKEM Holding. Under his leadership, the SEKEM Initiative received, amongst others, the „Alternative Nobel Prize“. SEKEM Holding consists of five companies. Some of their work involves the production of organic foods, natural remedies and organic cotton textiles.



Michael Brenner

Michael Brenner is Co-Managing Director of the Weleda Group. In his function he is responsible for the support and service areas of the company. These include beside others the areas of finance, human resources, organizational development, culture&identity and sustainability. Michael Brenner has been with Weleda since 2012.



Dr. Petra Derkzen

Dr. Petra Derkzen, Board Member of Demeter International and also, in a part-time collaboration with the Section for Agriculture, is involved in research, training and consultancy for the Biodynamic Movement. Derkzen is based in The Netherlands as a biodynamic farmer at Ekoboerderij de Lingehof, a 100-hectare farm focussing on large-scale vegetable and grain production.

**Gerald Häfner**

Head of the Social Sciences Section at the Goetheanum. Initiator, for example, of The Federal Foundation for the Reappraisal of the SED Dictatorship, the Petra Kelly Foundation, More Democracy and Democracy International. He co-founded the party 'Alliance 90 / The Greens'. Häfner was a member of the German Federal Parliament from 1987 to 2002 and a member of the European Parliament from 2009 to 2014.

**Thomas Jorberg**

Thomas Jorberg has been with the GLS Bank since 1986, and has been a member of the Executive Board since 1993 and Spokesman/Chairman of the Board since 2003. On receipt of a group application, the respective institution will receive the account for the group. Subsequent bookings can only be applied for and paid on an individual basis.

Credit cards (all countries): The full amount will be charged to your credit card as soon as your booking has been processed. You will receive postal or email confirmation of your booking and payment.

Invoice Switzerland: Confirmation of booking and an invoice will be sent to you once your booking has been processed. Please note that we only send out invoices up until 10 days before the beginning of an event. After that, payment is only possible by credit card or on arrival.

Invoice Eurozone: Confirmation of booking and an invoice will be sent to you once your booking has been processed (Euro account). Please note that we only send out invoices up until 14 days before the beginning of an event. After that, payment is only possible by credit card or on arrival.

Other countries: Once your booking has been processed you will receive a confirmation by post or email. The amount due will either be charged to your credit card or you can pay on arrival. Bank transfers are not possible.

Please note that the conference fee must be paid before the conference starts.

Conference tickets: Tickets can be collected at the Reception until half an hour before the conference starts, also if you pay on arrival. We accept cash (Euro and CHF), VISA, MasterCard, ec-direct and Postcard-Schweiz.

Cancellation: Bookings may be cancelled free of charge up to 14 days prior to the beginning of the conference (14.09.2018, date of posting). After that, 50% of the conference fee will be charged. Meals, breakfast, parking permit and group accommodation may be cancelled free of charge up to 1 day prior to the beginning of the conference (27.09.2018). Cancellation on the day when the conference begins or failure to attend are subject to a 100% invoice total. Substitutes will be accepted at no extra cost.
